Once the maximum number of admitted visitors has been reached, registration requests will be placed on a waiting list and sorted out in order of arrival.

All invoices will be sent electronically after the payment has been received.

#### **Cancellation Policy**

Cancellations must be received via email by April 6, 2025. No refunds can be made for cancellations received after this date.







As it is a Plenary Week in Strasbourg, **it can be very difficult to find reasonably priced accommodation**, as many hotels give preference to Members of the European Parliament and their team members or require a minimum booking of two or three nights. For this reason, **we strongly recommend that you book your accommodation as early as possible.** 

EFB has negotiated the following rates at the **<u>Sofitel Strasbourg</u>** <u>**Grande Ile**</u> hotel, where the seminars on May 7<sup>th</sup> will take place.

- Classic room: 280€/night, breakfast included for 1 person
- Superior room: 305€/night, breakfast included for 1 person
- Superior room with balcony or Luxury room: 330€/night, breakfast included for 1 person
- Premium Luxury room: 350€/night, breakfast included for 1 person
- Extra charge for double occupancy: 30€ per room and per night

The preferred rates and availability are applied for a mandatory 2-night's stay. The hotel will not be able to extend the conditions and guarantee the availability in case of a request for 1 night only

# Member of the European Parliament

Member of the European Parliament for the Socialists and Democrats Group, elected in 2024 North-West the in Italy constituency. Previously, City Councilor in Milan for 13 years, where he worked on Mobility, Urban Planning, and Housing.



Born in Milan in 1980, after completing his Scientific High School Diploma at Liceo Volta, he graduated in Political Science with a thesis on the Orange Revolution in Ukraine.

His political and institutional commitment began early, a few months before graduating high school, when he was elected as a Local District Councillor for two terms, focusing on territorial development and preservation issues. In 2006, he became a Municipal Councillor in Milan and served on the Mobility and Environment Committee. In 2011, he was appointed as the youngest Councillor in Mayor Pisapia's administration, with responsibilities for Mobility, Environment, Public Water, Energy, and the Subway.

In 2016, he was reconfirmed as Councilor by Mayor Beppe Sala with mandates for Urban Planning, Green Spaces, and Agriculture. In 2021, he became the most-voted candidate in municipal elections across Italy and was chosen for a third consecutive term as Councilor, this time with responsibilities for Housing and the Neighborhood Plan. From 2013 to 2016, he was the national delegate for mobility and local public services for the National Association of Italian Municipalities (ANCI).

# Member of the European Parliament

In 2022, he published a book analysing the ongoing transformations in major European cities, "Visible Cities: Where the Nation's Change Begins," Solferino, 2022. Two years later, he adapted it into a theatre production, "Visible Cities: Urban Landscapes in Search of an Author," which was performed sixteen times, mainly in the Lombardy region.

In 2024, after 13 years in Milan's city government, he ran for the European Parliament in the North-West Italy constituency and was elected with over 45,000 votes. As an MEP for the Socialists & Democrats group, he serves on the Committee (Internal Market IMCO and Consumer Protection) and the EMPL Committee (Employment and Social Affairs). He is also a member of the Euronest Parliamentary Assembly, the Delegation for relations with Bosnia and Herzegovina and Kosovo, and the Delegation for relations with the South Caucasus.

He is married with two children, Lorenzo and Viola.
